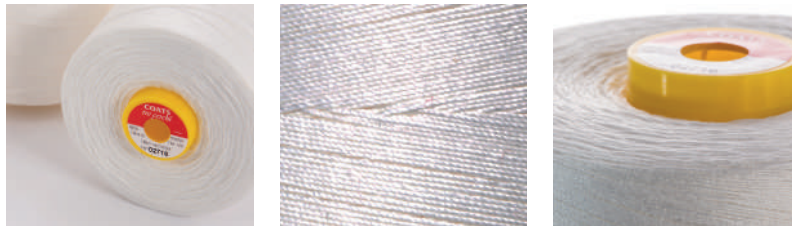

THERMAL PROPERTIES

Burns readily. Decomposes at 400°C

Prolonged exposure to sunlight causes yellowing and strength loss

Good durability. Shrinkage at 100°C typically 1% or less

Sensitive to temperatures greater than 350°C

CHEMICAL PROPERTIES

Acids:	Sensitive to mineral acids especially if halogenated
Alkalis:	Swells in caustic mercerising but is not damaged
Organic solvents:	Generally unaffected by most organic solvents. Generally unaffected by sodium hypochlorite, sodium perborate and peroxide bleaches under controlled conditions. There is a probability of strength loss if contaminated with iron during bleaching
Insects / microorganisms (mildew, rot):	Resistant to ageing and moth attacks but sensitive to mildew growth
Moisture regain:	Approximately 8%
Finishing:	The lubricants applied are designed to give consistent performance at high sewing speeds and a minimal variability between shades
Bleaching:	Good resistance to chlorine
Abrasion resistance:	Low
